Ming Chuan University Procedures for Students Enrolled in General Education

Passed at the General Education Center Affairs Meeting and the Curriculum Committee Meeting on July 19, 2010

Presented to the General Education Committee Meeting and Curriculum Committee Meeting for further review

- These procedures were established to comprehensively implement the General Education system.
- 2. These procedures apply to all students who are admitted to Ming Chuan beginning with the 2008-9 academic year and beyond.
- 3. As a graduation requirement, all students must complete a minimum of 12 credits of General Education elective courses.
- 4. To reinforce students' basic competencies and cultivate their appreciation for the humanities, citizenship and natural environment, the General Education electives are divided into three fields: humanities, social science and natural science. In each field, there are core course and extended course categories. In principle, all students are required to complete a minimum of 2 credits of course work for each category in each field.
- 5. These procedures shall be reviewed once every three years.
- 6. Upon being passed at General Education Center Faculty Meeting and submitted to the General Education Committee and University Affairs Committee for reference, these procedures were approved by the president and implemented. Any revision must follow the same procedures.

In the event of any inconsistency or discrepancy between the Chinese and other language versions of this document, the Chinese version shall prevail.
