

Ming Chuan University Procedures for Undergraduate Student Course Enrollment in the Five-year Combined Program

Passed at the Academic Affairs Committee Meeting on December 4, 2014

- Article 1 Procedures for Undergraduate Student Course Enrollment in the Five-year Combined Program been put in place to encourage excellent undergraduate students to remain at this institution to continue in their masters' programs at an accelerated pace through a period of continuous study.
- Article 2 Students with outstanding grades can apply to their respective departments every March and October.
Each department/ school should establish application qualifications and evaluation standards and announce them upon the approval of the president prior to processing students' applications.
- Article 3 Each department/ school should complete evaluation of applications prior the initial course selection of the following semester, compile the approved roster and report it to the Academic Affairs Division.
Students on the approved roster can select courses from their respective graduate programs starting from the next semester.
Students admitted through the referral examination for graduate programs are deemed as passing the evaluation.
- Article 4 Students who take graduate program courses and achieve a grade of 70 or above can apply for the credits not to be counted toward their bachelor's degree, and to receive a certificated of courses not listed on the undergraduate transcript, which document is the basis of credit waiver once the student is admitted to the graduate program.
The aforementioned course credits can waive up to one half of a master's program credits (The number of credits that can be waived does not include credits associated with the thesis, and is not subject to credit waiver limits imposed by individual graduate schools at the university.)
- Article 5 As this Procedures is implemented, the Procedures for Pre-matriculation Master's Program Course Enrollment is abolished.
- Article 6 Upon being passed at the Academic Affairs Committee Meeting and approved by the president, these procedures were announced and implemented.
