## Ming Chuan University Guidelines for Taking Academic Ethics Education Course

Passed at the Academic Affairs Committee Meeting on May 18, 2017

- Article 1 These guidelines are established to enhance students' research ethics so that they have correct ethics knowledge and attitude when engaging in academic research work to.
- Article 2 These guidelines are implemented beginning with graduate students admitted in and after 2017-18 academic year.
- Article 3 Implementation:
  - (1) Online self-study
  - (2) Self-study in the Academic Ethics Education Course offered by the Center for Taiwan Academic Research Ethics Education, an online teaching and learning platform.
  - (3) Need to pass at least the core course examination for the course prescribed above and obtain the course study certificate, prior to applying for the Oral Examination for Thesis Plan.
- Article 4 Any academic ethics education courses offered by a department/ School must be evaluated and passed by the Curriculum Committee. A passing grade in one of those courses will be recognized as passing an academic ethics education course.
- Article 5 Upon being passed at the Academic Affairs Committee Meeting and approved by the president, these guidelines were announced and implemented. Any revision must follow the same procedures.
