# Ming Chuan University Procedures for Encouraging Self-learning Projects

Article 1 In order to encourage students' self-learning and to increase their learning outcomes, as well as to support outstanding students to build up an assertive and responsible learning attitude, Ming Chuan University (hereafter referred to the university) established Ming Chuan University Procedures for Encouraging Self-learning Projects (hereafter referred to the procedures).
Article 2 The Teaching and Learning Resources Center (TLRC) will evaluate self-learning projects based on students' self-learning plans and outcome reports. Those who achieve their learning goals will be rewarded.
Article 3 The TLRC will also evaluate and reward outstanding self-learning projects with a certificate of merit and a prize based on self-learning group record, accuracy of outcome report and students' learning performance.
Article 4 Actual amounts issued and numbers of persons designated for awards are in accordance with the total subsidy amount for special projects each academic year.
Article 5 Awarded students must upload their self-learning outcome reports to MCU public platform and allow access for all MCU faculty and students.
Article 6 Upon being passed at the Administrative Council Meeting and approved by the president, these procedures were implemented. Any revision must follow the same procedure.

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
